Overview

Camp Code: **PEN261216WS**

Pench Tiger Reserve, nestled in the lower southern reaches of the Satpura hills is named after Pench River, which flows from north to south through the Pench National Park. It is located on the southern boundary of Madhya Pradesh. In 1992, Pench has been included under the umbrella of "Project Tiger" as the 19th Project Tiger Reserve.

A total of 758 Sq. kms of this Southern Indian tropical moist deciduous forest has its extent mingling with the tropical dry deciduous teak. The National Park is divided into two zones- the Core Zone comprising of 293 sq km while the Buffer Zone spread over an area of about 465 sq km. The area is crisscrossed by a number of streams most of which are seasonal.

Highlights of the camp :

- Explore Mowgli's Home with Foliage Outdoors !
- 5 jeep safaris to ensure sufficient opportunities to see and photograph wildlife.
- Beautiful deciduous forest spread along Pench Reservoir.
- Home to the two Big Cats - Tiger and Leopard.

- Pune to Pune escorted trip.
- Food during the train journey.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 Pune to Nagpur

Assemble at Pune Railway Station at 1630 hrs. Departure to Nagpur by train (3AC). Overnight train travel.

Day 2 Arrival at Nagpur, proceed to Pench. Evening Jeep safari.

Arrival at Nagpur in the morning. Proceed to Pench by AC SUVs (Innova). By 1200 hours, we will reach at our resort at Pench, check in and freshen-up followed by hot and sumptuous lunch.

Set out for the for the first jeep safari this evening. Return to the resort and get refreshed with a cup of hot coffee / tea. Dinner will follow soon. Overnight stay at Pench.

Day 3 Jeep Safari and Nature Trail at Pench.

Explore different parts of Pench National Park on morning jeep safari.

Walking nature trail around Pench National Park in the evening. Group Discussion - knowledge sharing session in the evening to know more about the wildlife seen during the first two safaris. Overnight stay at Pench.

Day 4 Jeep Safaris at Pench.

Today you will further explore this beautiful forest on morning and evening jeep safaris. Evening will be spent sharing experiences with each other over a cup of coffee / tea. Overnight stay at Pench.

Day 5 Morning safari at Pench, proceed to Nagpur.

One more jeep safari at Pench, to maximise the chances of tracking 'The Big Cat' !

Departure to Nagpur after lunch. Reach Nagpur by evening. Departure to Pune by train (3 AC). Overnight train travel.

Day 6 Arrival at Pune
